

BORAKALALA

Marloth Park House & Park Rules

Please read these rules carefully and make sure everyone in your group is aware of them. They are intended to protect the house, wildlife, neighbours and the peaceful character of Marloth Park.

STRICT NO-NOISE POLICY

- No loud or disturbing noise is permitted at any time. This includes loud music, shouting, screaming, loud conversations, parties or any other noise that may disturb neighbours or wildlife.
- After 18:00, noise must be kept to an absolute minimum every day of the week.
- If the noise rules are not adhered to, guests may be asked to leave the property. No exceptions will be made.

FIRE SAFETY

- Borakalala has a thatched roof. Please take extreme care with fires, hot coals and cigarettes.
- Large or uncontrolled open fires are not permitted. Use only the designated braai/fire area.
- All fires must be completely extinguished after use.
- Dry branches may not be collected from the veld for firewood. Please bring your own or purchase firewood locally.
- Cigarette butts may not be discarded on the ground. The house is a non-smoking area.

WILDLIFE & PARK ETIQUETTE

- Do not hand-feed animals. Feeding stations and waterholes are provided.
- Keep windows and doors securely closed when you leave. Baboons and monkeys are very active and can cause serious damage if they enter the house.
- No pets are allowed.
- Do not litter or disturb the natural environment.
- Please respect Marloth Park speed limits and always give wildlife right of way.
- No walking or cycling between 18:00 and 06:00.
- No fireworks, drones, spotlights, quad bikes or off-road driving.

REFUSE

- Use only the steel refuse cage indicated on the diagram placed on the fridge.
- DO NOT use the neighbour's steel cage. Costs resulting from refuse placed in the incorrect cage will be recovered from the guest.
- Only black refuse bags are allowed. Do not use Checkers or other shopping bags.
- Never place refuse bags on top of the cage. Baboons and monkeys will tear them open.

LOOKING AFTER THE HOUSE

- Please leave all furniture, equipment and facilities in the same condition in which they were received.
- If using paper plates, please check that knives and forks are not accidentally thrown away.
- Drying cloths are for drying dishes only. Please do not use them as dishcloths, pot holders or floor cloths.

- Please take note of the crockery provided. If anything breaks, kindly let the host know.
- Activate the alarm every time you leave the house.

PLEASE ALSO NOTE

- Parts of Borakalala are accessed by stairs and may not be suitable for small children, elderly guests or guests with disabilities.
- The road leading to the accommodation is a gravel road.
- Please report any problem or damage as soon as possible so that assistance can be arranged.
